How to Apply for International Trainings at GreenBiotec

A Step-by-Step Guide

Germany is a popular destination for students and professionals looking to gain valuable international experience through trainings. If you're interested in applying for a training in Germany, follow the steps outlined below.

Step 1: Submit Your Passport and Last Degree

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What is the maximum duration of the training program?

The maximum duration of the training program is 6 months.

Can my visa be extended after 6 months?

Yes, your visa can be extended based on a Job Search Visa. For graduated students, the extension can be up to 18 months, and for undergraduate students, up to 12 months.

What is the fee refund policy in case of visa rejection?

In the unfortunate event that your visa is rejected, your fee will be refunded, except for an HR fee of €500. This refund policy will be clearly stated in your admission letter.

What is the visa process duration?

The visa process typically takes 3 to 4 months.

What is the visa category for this international training?

The international training visa falls under category 16a. This is considered a work visa, not a study visa.

What are the minimum qualifications for admission to the internship program?

The minimum qualification required is a 10th class (Matric) education. The program is open to applicants up to the PhD/Post-doc level.

What are the language requirements?

There are no specific language requirements such as IELTS or German proficiency. However, a basic understanding of English, equivalent to a school level, is required.
